

## FRAMEWORK FOR EMPANELMENT OF AGENCIES FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT INITIATIVES

### 1. Compost Enrichment Unit

This category focuses on establishing a forward linkage for raw compost generated from existing LSGI facilities or households, ensuring it meets regulatory standards and is successfully marketed.

Key Feature	Private Facilities
<b>Primary Goal</b>	The agency shall be responsible for the professional branding, aggressive marketing, and efficient sale of the processed and enriched compost. Fortification of raw compost shall be done for ensuring it adheres to the quality standards specified in the <b>Solid Waste Management (SWM) Rules, 2016</b> .
<b>Contract Duration</b>	The empanelled agency shall undertake a minimum five-year (5 years) contract for fortification of the compost generated.
<b>Revenue Model</b>	Agencies will purchase raw compost at a minimum rate of <b>₹1 per kilogram (kg)</b> .
<b>Revenue Sharing</b>	nil

#### Scope of Work for Empanelled Agencies:

The selected agency shall undertake the following mandatory responsibilities:

- Agreement and Collection:** Formalize a legally binding agreement with the respective LSGIs/ Pvt facilities for the consistent and systematic collection of raw compost generated from their wet waste management facilities including households and community facilities.
- Storage and Processing Facility:** Establish and maintain a dedicated, well-equipped storage facility (godown) for the necessary processing and conversion of the raw compost, aiming to elevate its quality to meet the SWM Rules, 2016 standards.
- Quality Control and Testing:** Conduct mandatory initial testing of the raw compost received to analyze key parameters as stipulated by the SWM Rules. Furthermore, compliance must be ensured and documented through certified test reports *prior* to the packaging and final sale of the processed compost.
- Regulatory Compliance:** Strictly ensure unwavering adherence to all environmental regulations, guidelines, and standards prescribed by both the **Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB)** and the **State Pollution Control Board (SPCB)** throughout the processing and storage lifecycle.
- Logistics and Transportation:** Own or lease a dedicated fleet of vehicles specifically equipped with **GPS tracking systems** for the efficient, transparent, and traceable transportation of the compost.
- Record maintenance:** The agency shall maintain complete record of compost collected, test

reports of raw compost, quality test reports of enriched compost and the details of compost branded and market.

- **Experience Prerequisite:** Demonstrate substantial minimum one year prior experience and proven expertise in the professional management of organic waste streams and the production and handling of quality compost.
